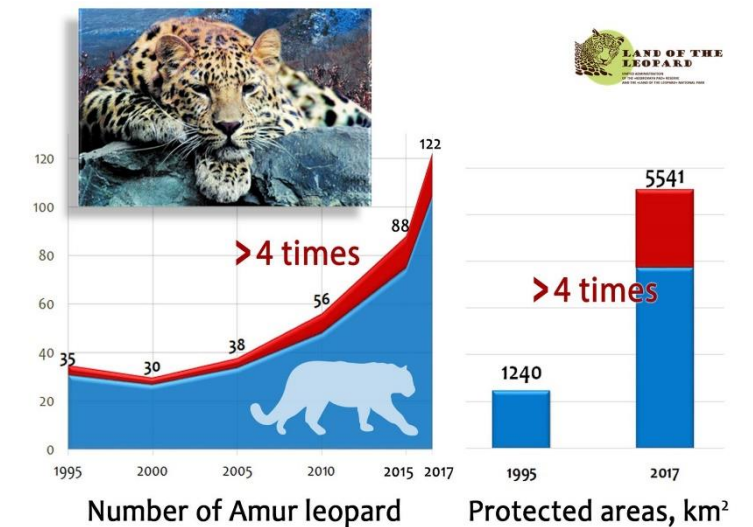
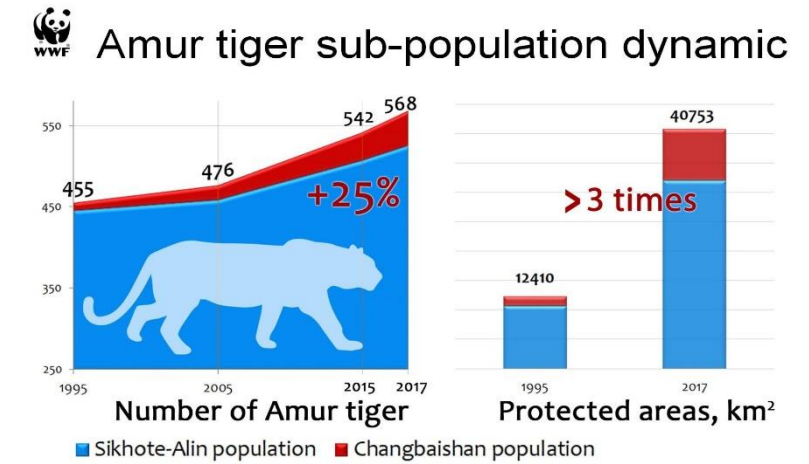
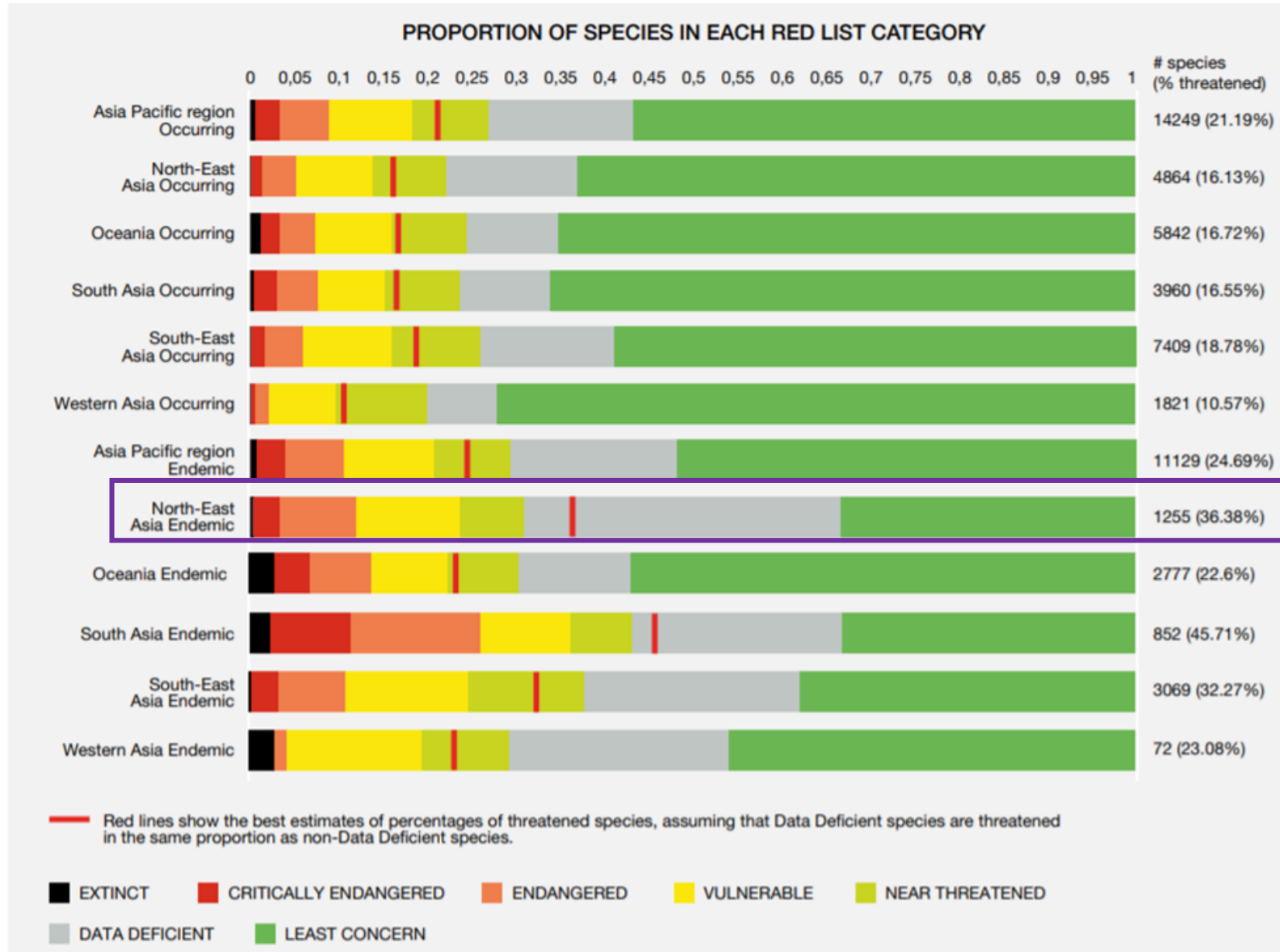


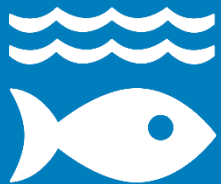
ENEA's Share of Global CO2 Emissions

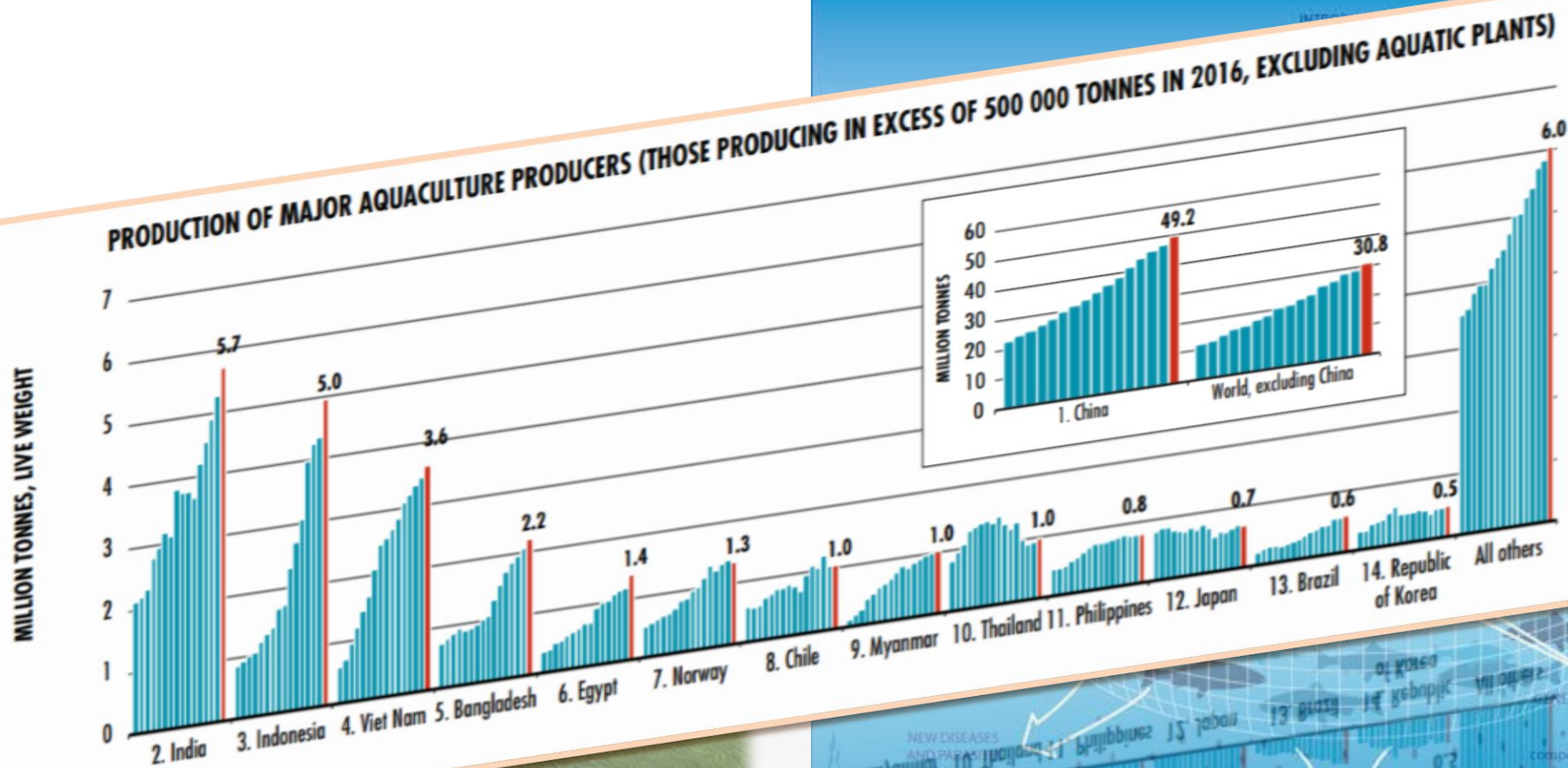


Biodiversity: Red List of Threatened Species, IUCN

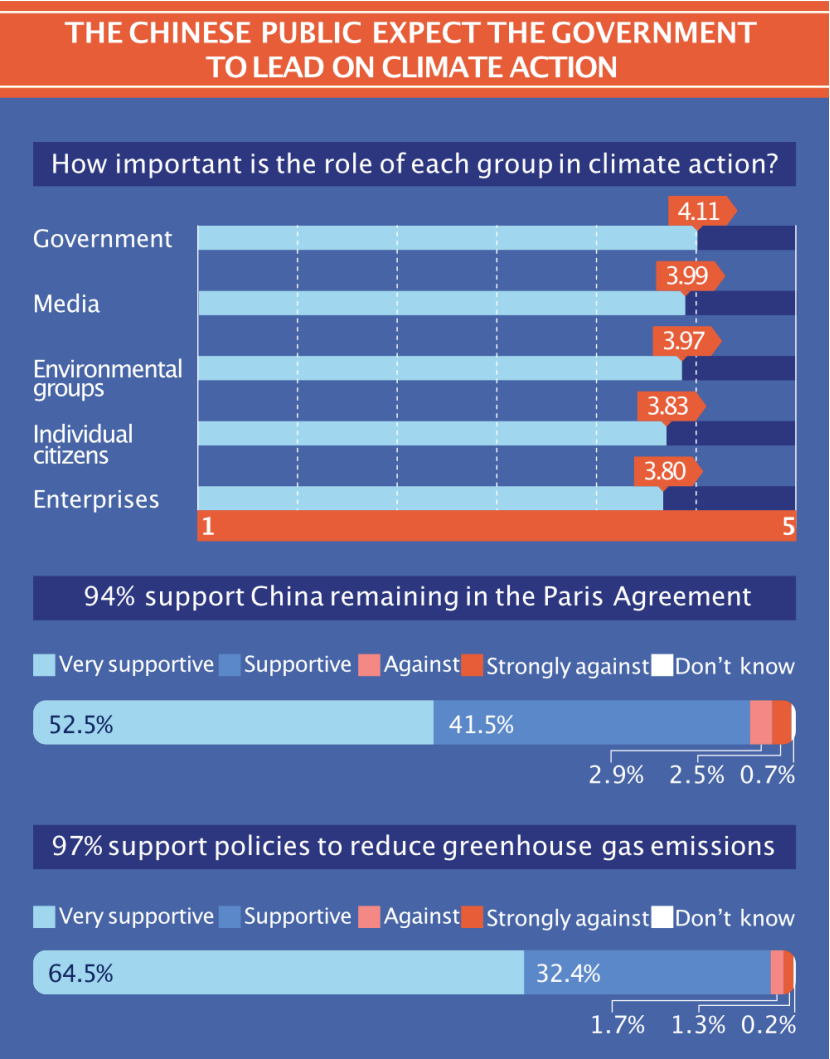

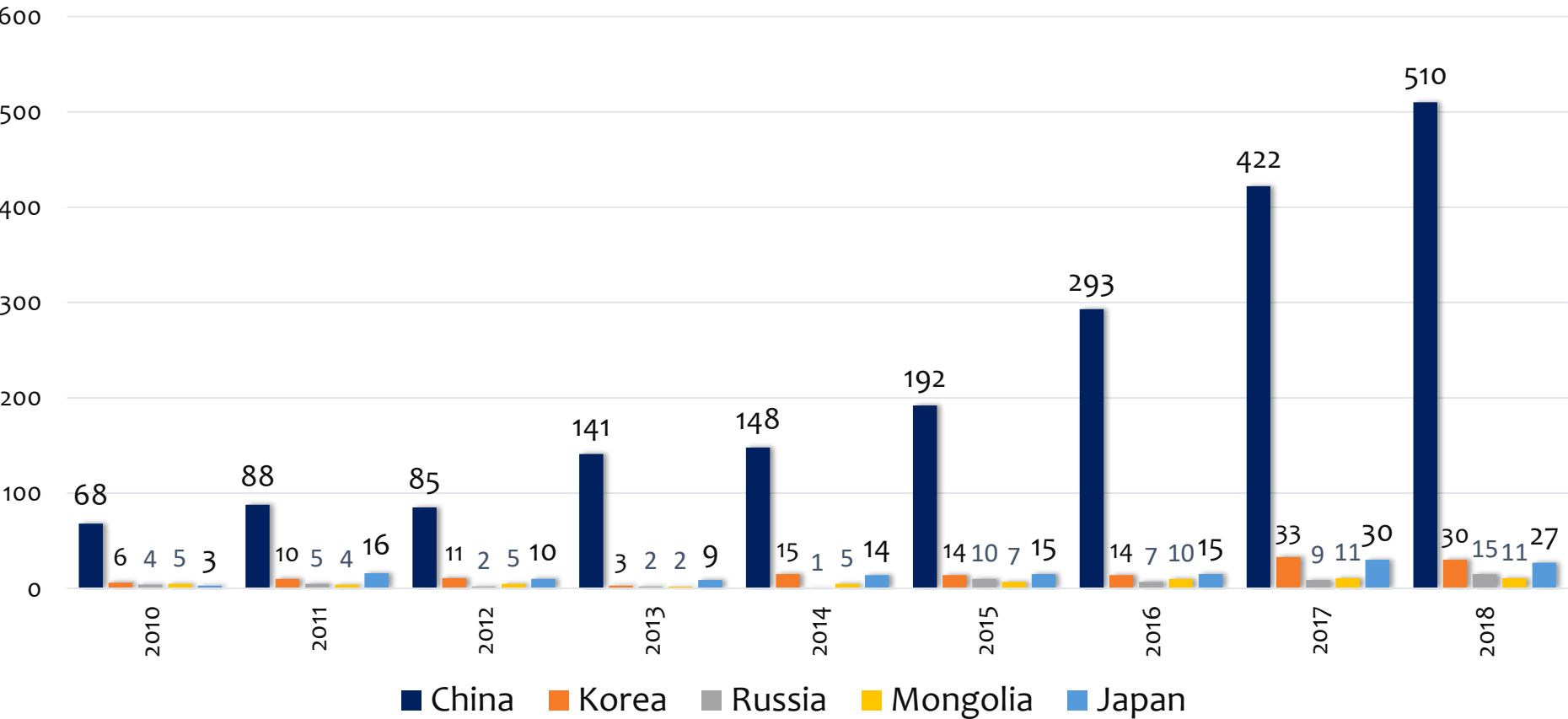

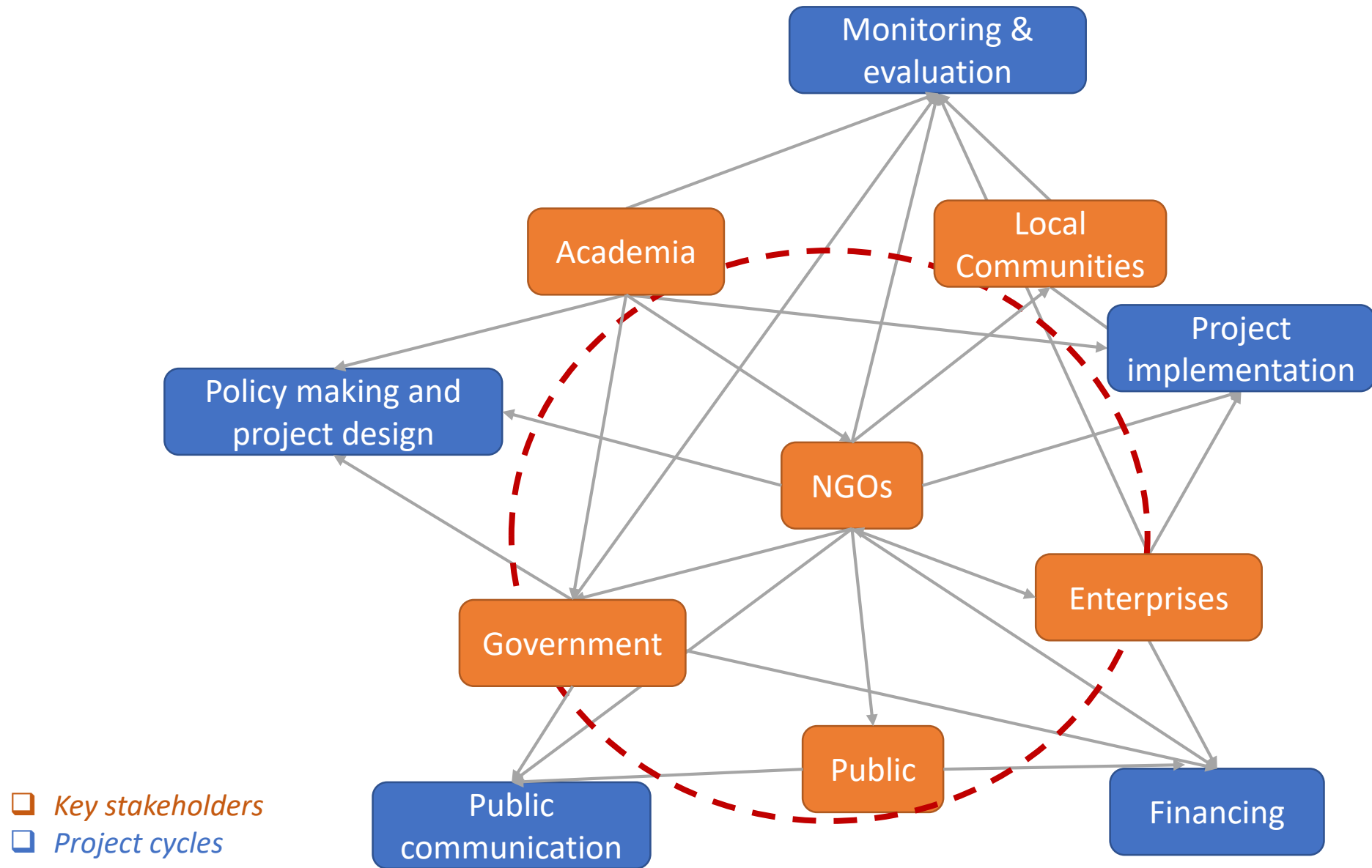
