We, the Asia-Pacific statistical community, comprising leaders of national statistical systems and development partners active in the region, share the vision that

*by 2030, national statistical systems are **enabled** and **empowered to lead** development of and to **deliver** innovative, trusted and timely products and services for **urgently needed and evolving statistical requirements of Agenda 2030.***

Action Areas

- Action area A: Engaging users and investing in statistics
- Action area B: Assuring quality and instilling trust in statistics
- Action area C: Integrated statistics for integrated analysis
- Action area D: Modernizing statistical business processes
- Action area E: Having requisite skills set

Principles for collective action

- *Building on national priorities and existing initiatives*
 - ***National indicator frameworks***
 - *National strategies for development of statistics*
 - *Localization of SDGs*
 - *Data flows, data sharing: better and stronger coordination among statistical producers and users*

Action Area A: Engaging users and investing in statistics

- *Objective 1:* National statistical systems are responsive to the needs of users, including those arising from the 2030 Agenda
- *Objective 2:* Investments in national statistical systems match the requirements for meeting demands and needs of users

Action area B: Assuring quality and instilling trust in statistics

- *Objective 1:* Legal frameworks enabling NSOs to drive transformation towards better coordination, system-wide quality assurance frameworks, *efficient data flows, and modernized statistical business processes.*
- *Objective 2:* Formulate and implement national monitoring frameworks for development strategies through the SDG lens
- *Objective 3:* National statistical systems have implemented a system-wide quality assurance framework
