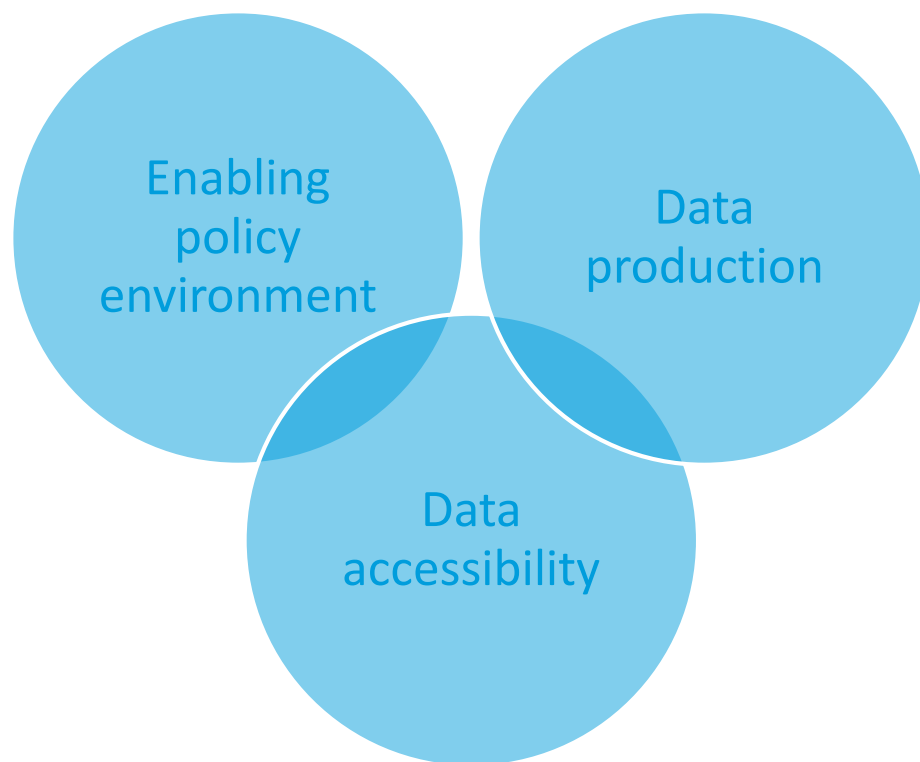

 - Identification of data gaps: connects data demands to data inventories and sources.
 - Mapping data demands: inventories of national, regional and global policies.
 - Data planning: implementation progress and institutional bottlenecks.
