 - Located between
 - latitude 5°55′ to 9°50′ north and
 - longitude 79°42′ to 81° 52′ East.
 - Total area 65,610 sq.km.
 - Maximum length of 432 km along the North-South direction
 - Maximum width of 224 km along the East-West direction.

Population of approximately 20.33 million as at 2012


- The growth rate is 0.9%.

Asian Highways in Sri Lanka

• There are two routes

AH43 and AH44

■ Total length of both these routes is approximately 650 km.



A43:

- Continues from Dhanuskody in India and enters Sri Lanka through Talaimannar in the island of Mannar
- and passes through
 - Medawachchiya,
 - Anuradhapura,
 - Dambulla,
 - Kurunegala, connects Kandy from Kurunegala
 - Colombo Very close to the Capital City Sri Jayawardenepura,
 - Galle
- ends at Matara.



Problems in land acquisition

Recent Developments

- Southern Expressway from Colombo to Galle (95.28 km) is in operation since November 2011. Construction of Southern Expressway from Galle to Matara (30 km) is nearing completion. These two sections of the Southern Expressway are parallel to the Colombo Galle Matara section of the Asian Highway (AH43).
- Action is being taken to commence construction of Northern Expressway Phase I which will connect Colombo with major cities Kandy and Kurunegala. This will be an alternative route for sections of the Asian Highway AH43 from Kurunegala to Colombo
- An outer ring road to Colombo city which is named as "Outer Circular Highway" is being constructed; this will serve as a bypass road for the traffic from the Northern part of the country towards the Southern part of the country on AH43 avoiding traffic congestion within Colombo city.

Recent Developments

Action is being taken to extend the Southern Expressway by another 96km up to Hambantota. Construction works are scheduled to be commenced shortly.
