<b>Summary</b>	The goal of the programme was to raise the awareness of communities on the various types of natural disasters such as tsunami, storm surge, flood etc. and on the value of disaster reduction through development of community based hazard maps. The programme was based on ADRCs capacity building projects carried out previously in Vietnam and Sri Lanka.		
<b>Final results</b>	Workshops were held in Chennai and Dhaka to develop a community-based hazard map based on scientific products and 'town-watching'. Through the training, the participants recognized the community based hazard mapping as a useful tool to enhance the awareness of the community to the disaster risk reduction. 1200 DVDs and reports of the workshop were disseminated to the national and local government officers related to disaster risk management. The methodology for community based hazard mapping was incorporated in the curriculum of Anna University.
