Summary	<p>The project was aimed at collecting and sharing tsunami awareness materials, hazard information and preparedness tools from Indonesia, Thailand and the Philippines for wider public awareness and education.</p> <p>To ensure the use of the materials, education and awareness activities were carried out in coastal areas. Moreover, the project assessed the adequacy of the materials within each country's context, taking into consideration communities' native languages and making adjustments when necessary (UNESCO collaborated with the implementing partners: Thailand, Indonesia and the Philippines to achieve this).</p>		
Final results	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A regional depository for tsunami awareness materials developed at JTIC. 2. A total of 20 education materials on tsunami awareness were produced. Materials were made available in national languages based on each country's needs, and lessons were shared with a wider number of countries through a regional workshop at the end of the project. Activities in the Philippines were scaled up using national budgets. 3. Capacity building activities conducted through workshops for trainers, school students, the media and the relevant authorities. All these activities used the information kits developed through this project, including tsunami teacher DVD, tsunami glossary, stickers and flipcharts. 4. The JTIC website was developed, and training on managing the website was carried out. Moreover the website was translated into five different languages (English, Bahasa, Indonesian, Thai, Tagalog and Tetun).
