Objectives of the PIMS

- To deliver PPP projects according to expected timelines and quality
- To establish accountability for results
- To ensure fully transparent progression of each PPP project across its project cycle





Challenges in Implementing PPPs

- Numerous project tasks and roles to deliver from project preparation to project implementation
- Multiple government agencies are involved in various stages of PPP projects
- Project documents are stored in silos
- Monitoring of projects is a huge task particularly on the tracking of progress and status of projects



The Solution

- **Project Management Approach (PMA)**

This is the over-all methodology for organizing, planning, coordinating, and reporting that are needed for each project.

- **Project Information and Management System (PIMS)**

A web-based tool to be used by the PPP Project Team members from project preparation, evaluation, procurement, and implementation of PPP projects.



Functions of the PIMS

Functions cover:

- a) Planning, scheduling, and monitoring of project tasks for each stage of the project cycle (preparation, evaluation, procurement, implementation)
- b) Sharing of project information, data, and documents across team members of each project stage
- c) Capturing lessons learned and good practices
- d) Generating reports (Gantt Chart & Dashboards format): project level, stage level, and task level

PIMS users:

- a) government agencies' project team members
- b) project consultants
- c) heads and concerned officers of agencies involved in the project
- d) oversight agencies and other stakeholders



Who is developing PIMS?

- Sustainable Infrastructure Foundation (SIF) using the SOURCE platform
- PIMS project is being supported by the ADB (under the Asia Pacific Project Preparation Facility - AP3F Technical Assistance)
- Beyond the AP3F TA, SIF will continue to support PIMS through the multilateral banks (MDBs)
- Status of PIMS:
on-going customization/development
September 2019 - system testing
